



Visa Account Updater Service Opt-Out Form

Visa Account Updater (VAU) is an account updating service in which your NIH Federal Credit Union Visa Debit Card and/or Credit Card is automatically enrolled. When your card(s) expire, are lost or stolen and new cards are issued, the VAU service may update relevant card data (card numbers and expiration dates) to appropriate merchants who participate in VAU, in an effort to facilitate uninterrupted processing of your recurring charges. This service provides updates to a Visa database only. The database is accessed by those qualified merchants seeking your account information after you have requested they process a recurring payment or payments. This service is provided as a free benefit to you to help facilitate uninterrupted processing of your recurring payments. You may opt-out of the VAU service at any time.
